Projects and Programs

Over the years, GTL has partnered with organizations like <u>Williette Safehouse</u> to host an after school taekwondo sports club for hearing impaired students who attended the Monrovia School for the Deaf.

GTL launched the Sports United Project to offer support and resources to Liberian-based athletes and cultivate various sports within the country.

The Sports United Project allows **GTL** to promote and educate the community about various sports, work with federations and stakeholders to identify elite athletes, seek out resources to sponsor qualified athletes, share the journey, maintain transparency, and hold federations accountable.



Federations

Through our partnerships, **GTL** has covered the Liberia Olympic team in Tokyo and renewed the relationship for the Paris2024, Dakar2026, and LA2028 Games.

The Liberia Taekwondo Federation successfully hosted its first national tournament, the first time in 10 years. Through the support of GTL, all coaches have been level II certified by World Taekwondo.


